- 5. If a plastic bag ends up in the ocean, what do you think could happen to it and the sea creatures?
- 6. Instead of using plastic bags, what other things can we use to carry our groceries or toys?
- 7. Besides plastic bags, can you think of other plastic things we use every day? What could we use instead of those plastic items?
- 8. The book talks about recycling. What does "recycling" mean? If you need help, ask an adult to explain it to you. Why is recycling important?
- 9. The Lonely Plastic Bag teaches us about sustainability. That means taking care of our planet. Can you think of two ways you can help take care of the Earth?
- 10. Think about the beautiful world we live in, with all its plants, animals, and natural wonders. Draw a picture of your favourite part of nature and show how you would protect it from harm.
