3. What are some fun things you like to do with your sibling? (If you haven't got a sibling, think about a cousin or a best friend.)

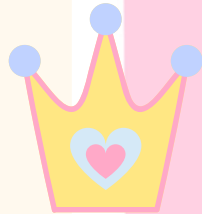
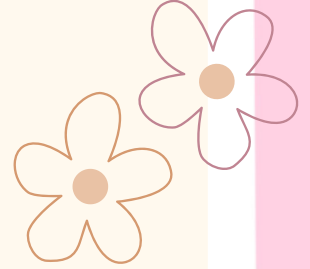
4. When one of the sisters is hurt, what does the other one do?
